## **Cenotaph Tree Carving**

A grant application was submitted by the MCPA to the Community Bank Deloraine and Districts to create a carving from one of the Macrocarpa Pine trees near the Cenotaph on Pioneer Drive. The application was successful and, with additional funding from the MCPA, Eddy and Fiona Freeman were commissioned to carve the tree.

The carving will be in acknowledgement of our local Vietnam Veterans. One Macrocarpa Pine tree was cut down and the other trimmed

in preparation for carving in late February. Carving began in early April this year and is expected to be completed by June 2022.
