The Ye Old Railway Op Shop, situated opposite the Post Office in Pioneer Drive, was started by Enid Miles over 30 years ago. It has continued to operate through the dedication of volunteers from the Mole Creek Progress Association (MCPA). Margo Howe, Margaret Barwick and Betty Richards (right) have been three of the longest serving volunteers.



The Op Shop building is leased from the Meander Valley Council and is maintained by the MCPA. Renovations by the MCPA over the last two years have included;

- A new heater donated by Doug and Ramona Westbrook,
- Weatherboards replaced and painted through Hydro Tasmania Grant Funding attained by the MCPA,
- Interior painted and refurbished, including re-carpeting and new hanging racks, through donations of time and materials by community volunteers.



The shop re-opened on the 22nd of Jan 2020 and reported record sales due to the new layout.
